Background:

International guidelines for conducting research in an ethical way became a must in research conduction and publications. Health research ethics went through a long way for developing codes of ethics. This started since the Nuremberg trials which showed that there is a distinction between the health practice ethics and the health research ethics. The declaration of Helsinki 1962 was the first act for establishing codes of research ethics. It has been revised several times. CIOMS (Council of International Organization of Medical Sciences) published the first regulation and codes of ethics based on the Declaration of Helsinki in 2002. IOMS (Islamic Organization of Medical Sciences) made a peer review of the CIOMS publication and published its comments.

The Arab region has its own cultural identity and traditions. This unique situation of the Arab world is based on the unity of language, culture, traditions, religion, socioeconomic criteria and demographic distribution. Arab researchers need to be more informed about research ethics to contribute more in international research projects for the sake of improvement of the health conditions of the whole Arab world

Aim:

- To distribute the health research ethics codes among Arab researchers.
- To enhance the practical application of ethics in medical research in the Arab countries regarding its unique religious, cultural and traditional background.
